

## **PROMPT EXAMPLES FOR RISK ASSESSMENTS**

### **LEVEL 1 - NO RISK (Prompt Example)**

During week of \_\_\_\_\_ there were no risks/threats. No fights occurred, and Safety Ambassadors were present to alleviate any potential conflicts.

### **LEVEL 2 – LOW RISK (Prompt Example)**

During week of \_\_\_\_\_ there were low risk incidents of conflict and/or fights occurring **within** the school environment. These conflicts were handled and/or resolved **within** the school premises and do not possess the potential to escalate or carry outside of school grounds.

### **Level 3 – MEDIUM RISK (Prompt Example)**

### **Level 4 - HIGH RISK (Prompt Example)**
